Dimorphotheca has single flowers of 5 cm diameter.

Temperature:

16-22 °C daytime, 2-9 °C night time.

Height:

Pot: 18-20 cm in height and diameter

Garden: 25-30 cm in height.

Growth Regulator:

One spray with 1000 ppm Cycocel or 2500 ppm Alar spray at 2-4 true leaves stage.

Special Instructions:

- Use a well drained soil mix and keep on the dry side.
- Dimorphotheca require low temperature (below 10 °C) to set multiple flower buds.
- The cooler the temperature, the higher the bud count and the more compact the plants will be.
