Gypsophila.

Caryophyllaceae.

**Plant Type:**

Annual.

**Promotional Name:**

Garden Bride & Gypsy.

**Transplant Date:**

March - November.

**Flower Date:**

**Packs:** Spring + 3-4 weeks, Autumn + 4-5 weeks, Winter + 5-6 weeks.

**Pots:** Spring + 6-8 weeks, Autumn + 8-9 weeks, Winter + 9-10 weeks.

**Hanging Baskets:** Spring + 9-11 weeks, Autumn + 11-12 weeks, Winter + 12-13 weeks.

**Use:**

Garden Bride: hanging baskets. Gypsy: border plants or shapely silhouettes in containers or pots.

**Containers:**

Hanging baskets 20cm, pots 15cm, packs.

**Potting:**

5 – 6 weeks after potting in 10cm (4") pots. Pot 1 plug per pot and 3-5 plugs per hanging basket depending on the required size of the finished product.

**Potting Soil:**

Fertilised peat with a pH of 5.5 – 6.5.

**After Potting:**

Plants grown on in a frost free greenhouse can be grown outdoors when the risk of frost has passed.

**Watering:**

Plants must not dry out.

**Fertilisation:**

If pots are placed outside it can be recommended to add 2g Osmocote per pot to maintain the fertiliser level during rainy periods.

**Production Time:**

Packs - visible buds, spring sales 3 - 4 weeks after transplant.

Pots – spring sales 6 - 8 weeks after transplant.

Hanging baskets – spring sales 9 - 11 weeks after transplant.

**Remark:**

The first flowers of Gypsy may come out as singles. As light levels increase the fully double flowers will bloom.
