REPLACES PRINCE COLOURS

Nakayasu is basal branching, with good vigour and uniformity. Calendula prefer cool temperatures, however during the cold season do not overwater as moist conditions will lead to black rot. When grown during hot conditions the flowers will be smaller. By pinching the centre stem 60 days after sowing, the plant will produce 8-10 good quality cut flowers. Height 91-110cm.

Becoming increasingly popular, Prince can be grown year round as not daylength sensitive. Good double flowered cutting variety for cool greenhouse and outdoor culture, suitable for forcing. Height 60cm.
